This year, SCOT will be hosting the SCOT Summer Season 2025 on a larger scale to commemorate its 50th Anniversary since the relocation of the company to Toga.

In 1976, theatre director Suzuki Tadashi relocated his theatre company, Suzuki Company of Toga (SCOT) to Toga, remodeled one of the farmhouses into a theatre called Toga Sanbo, and commenced the company's activities there.

“As You Wish”

Since 2013, SCOT has adapted a new production format whereby performances in Toga are open to the public with no standard ticket charge. Instead, we ask you to pay what you can or “as you wish.” You can make this payment by wire transfer or credit card, or while in Toga, before or after watching the performances at the ticket booth in cash.

Also, please let us know if you would like to make reservations for any charter buses and SCOT Summer Season Special Tent Site.

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- There are only two public city buses per day running to Toga from Etchu-Yatsuo st./Inami st. We recommend taking the charter buses that are scheduled in conjunction with the performances.
 - Accommodations in Toga are limited so make your reservation early.
 - There are no ATMs in the village so we suggest you bring a fair amount of cash with you.
- Payment is only accepted in cash in Toga. Credit cards and e-commerce are not accepted.
- There are no convenience stores or shops around the area. Meals and merchandise can be purchased at the Gurume-kan (food court).
 - We will provide an English information counter at the Gurume-kan.
 - There are many insects during the summer. We suggest that you bring insect repellent and proper attire for protection.
 - The temperature can drop below 10 degrees Celsius in the mornings and evenings. Be sure to bring warm clothes with you.
 - We will carry on with the performance at the Open Air Theatre and the Rock Theatre even if it rains; however, you will not be able to use an umbrella. Please make sure to bring a raincoat with you.
 - A free shuttle bus will be available to take you between the venues and the Gurume-kan.
 - Depending on the performance, multilingual explanatory paper may be provided. Please ask at the ticket booth.
